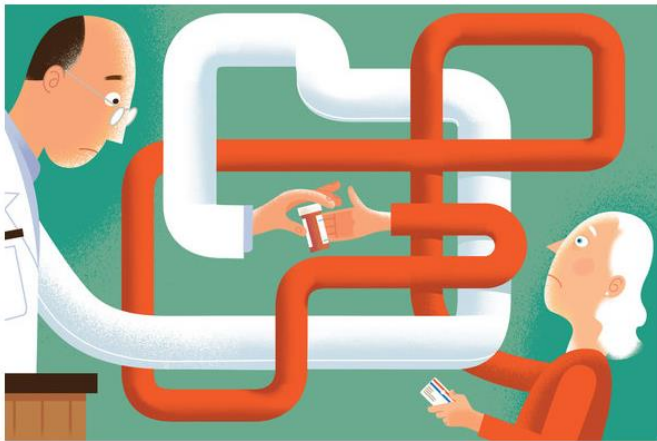


The War on Drug Prices: Innovation vs. Affordability
